DRAWING: Materials List

'General' (5 Days)

- * Clothing worn should be comfortable and suitable for relaxing in
- * Suitable Backing Support Board for positioning your paper for drawing (*Larger than paper*)
- * Suitable Desk Easel or Platform - to hold backing support board for paper
- * Several (*At least 4*) Bulldog or Fold Back Clips (*50mm wide*) (*Optional*)
- * 1 block/pad of Cartridge Drawing Paper or 10 x Cartridge Drawing Sheets (*A3 size*)
- * Colourfix or Tex Pastel Paper (*A3 size*) (*2 x Sand*) * Tracing paper (*A4*)
- * Pencils, 2b, 4b, 6b + Kneaded Eraser + Adjustable Pen Eraser
- * Willow or Vine Charcoal Sticks.. 2mm + 6mm (*1 of each*) * Battery Eraser (*Optional*)
- * 1 x Charcoal Pencil (*Soft*) * 1 x Round Compressed Charcoal Stick (*Soft*)
- * Pencil Sharpener * Blending Stump (*Tortillions*) Paper * Can of Spray Workable
- * 25 mm Masking Tape for securing paper to board * Packet of Wet Ones
- * A Portfolio folder and/or a box (to carry your drawings and paper around)
- * Box of Soft Tissues * Clean Soft Cotton Cloth or rags * One Old Towel
- * 2 meter Tape Measure or Ruler * Craft knife
- * Note pad and pen for taking notes * Plastic Bag for rubbish
- * Tablet or Ipad with charger (*Optional*) (*Containing your reference photos*)

Reference photos or objects

- * Suitable Photos for Reference (*Printed onto photo quality paper or on your tablet*)
- Useful to bring e.g. (*Landscape, Seascape, City Scape, Flowers, Favourite Animal or Subject, Etc..*)
- * A Cover Sheet for your table (*Plastic or Cloth*) for a 2m x 1m table...
